

Site preparations for upcoming construction

To prepare for the construction of the Surrey Langley SkyTrain, early works are underway in the area. Starting on September 9 and lasting for approximately two weeks, crews will be working on clearing, grubbing, removing and disposing of vegetation and debris along Fraser Highway at the following locations:

- Fraser Highway & 96 Avenue
- Fraser Highway & 140 Street
- Fraser Highway & 176 Street/Highway 15
- Fraser Highway & 203A Street

Work will be conducted during the day. Major traffic impacts are not anticipated, and noise will be minimal. Access for emergency responders, residents and businesses will be maintained throughout construction.

What to Expect



Timing

Early to mid-September 2024.



Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.



Traffic

A westbound lane will temporarily be closed between 140 Street and 96 Avenue. Roadside signage will provide advance notification and traffic control personnel will be onsite to direct traffic and pedestrians as required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Noise, dust, vibrations may occur from construction equipment including, saws, woodchippers, excavators, dump trucks, rollers, and hand tools.
