

UPDATED: Test piling activities at Industrial Ave and 203 Street

To prepare for the construction of the Surrey Langley SkyTrain, early works are underway in the area. As part of early construction work, crews will complete "test piles" which are expected to begin the week of October 21 and continue through early December 2024.* Pile installation involves driving a long metal tube (pile) into the ground to provide the foundation for a structure. The purpose of the test piles is to provide geotechnical information for the design and construction of the new Langley City Centre Station.
