



Foundation Construction along Fraser Highway

Current construction activities for the Surrey Langley SkyTrain project include preparing sites and ground improvements to support the future guideway piers and SkyTrain Stations. Construction of the foundations for guideway piers requires drilling or driving steel and concrete piles into the ground, with specialized equipment, including large mobile cranes and drill rigs (as pictured below).

Foundation construction is anticipated to begin at the following locations along Fraser Highway:

- 152 Street (future 152 St Station): mid-November 2024 to spring 2025
- 160 Street (future Fleetwood Station): December 2024 to spring 2025
- 166 Street (future Bakerview-166 St Station): mid-November 2024 to spring 2025
- 176 Street: December 2024 to fall 2025
- 184 Street (future Hillcrest-184 St Station): mid-November 2024 to spring 2025

Timing

Mid-November 2024 to spring 2026 for foundation construction at the locations noted above. Please visit our website for updates.



Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Deliveries outside of construction hours will be required and adhere to applicable permit requirements.



Traffic

Traffic pattern changes are anticipated around work areas, please refer to our traffic updates where applicable.



Impacts/Interruptions

Temporary increases in noise levels are anticipated. Monitoring for noise and vibrations will be in place while work is underway.
