

SCHEDULE UPDATE: Traffic Pattern and Project Update - Fraser Highway and 166 Street



Map: Traffic pattern changes on 166 Street and along Fraser Highway

Traffic pattern changes previously planned for mid-November are being rescheduled; please see below for updates. Construction activities for the Surrey Langley SkyTrain project, including drilling piles for foundations and relocating underground utilities, are underway near Fraser Highway and 166 Street. As a result of this work, the following traffic pattern changes will occur:

- Right turn lane onto Fraser Highway from 166 Street slightly shifts.
- Access to/from the Surrey Sport & Leisure Complex will be closed at Fraser Highway. Access is maintained via 166 Street.
- Westbound right lane closure on Fraser Highway.

Businesses will remain open and accessible during construction. Please refer to TransLink signage and their website (TransLink.ca) for the latest information about bus service in this area.

The permanent closure of access to/from 8215 166 Street is in effect. The Fleetwood Youth Park (skateboard park) will remain closed during construction.

What to Expect



Timing

Traffic pattern changes are expected to begin December 2024, through spring 2025. We will share updates once available.



Traffic

Access changes on 166 Street and Fraser Highway. Westbound right lane closure on Fraser Highway in this area.



Hours of Work

Lane closure and pedestrian detour: 24/7
Construction schedule: Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.



Impacts/Interruptions

Pedestrians will be detoured onto 166 Street (see map for details). Cyclists will share the road with traffic.
