


Surrey Langley SkyTrain on Industrial Avenue



The SkyTrain will run along Industrial Avenue from 200 Street to 203A Street.

- An elevated guideway on the south side with landscaping and lighting
- Langley City Centre Station and transit exchange
- Walking and cycling paths on the south side of Industrial Avenue
- A sidewalk on the north side of Industrial Avenue
- Walking and cycling paths east of 203 Street
- Propulsion power substation, infrastructure that supplies electrical power to the SkyTrain system
- Industrial Avenue will be extended to 203A Street, and 203A Street will be extended to connect to Fraser Highway

Construction Timeline

2025

Activities starting include:

- Utility relocations
- Foundation construction, including driven piles at the station and for the guideway

2026-2027

Between 2026 and 2027 the majority of construction will take place, including:

- Guideway installation
- Utility installation and propulsion power station
- Station and transit exchange construction
- Installation of multi-use paths, sidewalks and final roadwork
- Trackwork and systems

2028

Smaller-scale construction activity related to finishing work, systems and commissioning.

Ongoing transit service in this area during construction. After construction, bus stops will shift closer to Langley City Centre Station.



It is anticipated that construction will take place during daytime hours. If overnight work is required, we will provide advance notice. Our contractors will monitor noise and use strategies to minimize noise, as needed.



Our Contractors

SkyLink Guideway Partners (SLGP) will build the elevated guideway and associated roadworks, utilities, and active transportation elements.

South Fraser Station Partners (SFSP) will build the SkyTrain station and propulsion power substation, as well as the final 250 metres of elevated guideway along Industrial Avenue.

Transit Integrators BC (TIBC) will build the electrical systems and trackwork.






Industrial Avenue in the Future
