

Station Construction Underway at Clayton Station Site

Construction of the Surrey Langley SkyTrain is progressing, with work beginning at the new Clayton Station on Fraser Highway at 190 Street (east of 189 Street). Station foundation construction, including pile driving, will begin mid-May and continue through late July. Foundation construction involves the use of large mobile cranes and drill rigs. An increase in noise and vibration is expected. Excavation and other activities will follow foundation construction through the end of July 2025.

What to Expect



Timing

Pile driving activities are expected to take place from mid-May to late July 2025. Construction will continue at this location following this work.



Hours of Work

Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Pile driving activities will occur until 5 p.m.



Traffic

Single lane traffic is already in effect in the area. An increase in construction vehicles and equipment accessing this site.



Impacts/Interruptions

Temporary increases in noise levels are anticipated during pile driving. Monitoring for noise and vibration will be in place while this work is underway.
