



Weekly Traffic Advisory: June 16 – June 22, 2025

Surrey Langley SkyTrain construction is underway, including relocating existing utilities to allow for construction, installing new utilities to supply power for the future SkyTrain, roadwork, foundation construction, pier construction, and other miscellaneous activities.

This advisory outlines traffic pattern changes during the week of June 16 – June 22, 2025. Workplans and schedule are subject to change.

Please note that single lane traffic throughout the project area is expected until project completion. There will be intermittent, short-term, lane closures on approaches to intersections, including stoppages of up to two minutes. These may not be reflected in this weekly traffic advisory. Cyclists can expect changes to cyclist lanes and multi-use paths along Fraser Highway while construction is underway. We have included information for cyclists in this advisory for planned traffic pattern changes.
