Re: Vegetation clearing at Fraser Highway and Highway 15

To support the growing transportation needs in the region, South of Fraser Maintenance and Storage Facility (SFMSF) is under development in Surrey. Located at the southeast corner of Fraser Highway and Highway 15 (176 Street), the SFMSF will serve as a necessary SkyTrain vehicle storage and maintenance facility to support the region's SkyTrain network.

Starting March 1, tree clearing and vegetation management will get underway on the site. There will be a temporary increase in noise while the work is taking place. Additional site preparation activities will continue through 2025.

Work schedule:

- March 1-15: 7 days a week, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- March 15 onwards: Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The trees and vegetation located in the southeastern corner of the site will remain in place. North Creek Park, south of the site, will not be impacted (see map).
