

# Traffic Update: Turn restrictions at Fraser Highway and 64 Avenue

Construction for the Surrey Langley SkyTrain is underway. Activities include foundation construction, pier construction, utility relocations, installation of new utilities to power the SkyTrain and road works. To allow for utility work within the intersection at 64 Avenue and Fraser Highway, turning restrictions will be required.

To support this work, the following traffic changes will be in effect from August 14, 2025, until August 29, 2025:

- Traffic on both Fraser Highway and 64 Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction 24/7.
- No left turns in any direction at the Fraser Highway and 64 Avenue intersection.
- Vehicle traffic may wish to use alternate routes.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained using available crosswalks and support from traffic control personnel, as needed.
- Cyclists will continue to follow the existing detour that is in effect until summer 2026.
- Businesses will remain accessible during construction.

## What to Expect



#### Timing

In effect from August 14 to August 29, 2025.



### **Hours of Work**

Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Lane closures and turning restrictions will be in effect 24/7.



#### Traffic

Single lane traffic in each direction on Fraser Highway and 64 Avenue. No left turns at Fraser Highway and 64 Avenue intersection.



## Impacts/Interruptions

The travelling public can expect delays while in the area. Temporary increases in noise are anticipated while work is taking place.
