

Traffic Update: Temporary Access Closure at 159 Street North of Fraser Highway

Construction for the Surrey Langley SkyTrain is underway. Activities include the construction of a new utility at the intersection at Fraser Highway and 159 Street.

To support this work, the following traffic changes will be in effect August 22 and August 25, 2025, and mid-September 2025 for up to five days:

- No access to/from 159 Street north of Fraser Highway.
- Turning restrictions will be in place at this intersection.
- Drivers should use 160 Street and 88 Avenue to reach 159 Street and follow posted signs.
- Pedestrians will be detoured around the work area using available crosswalks and support from traffic control personnel, as needed.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained during construction.
