## **Traffic Update: Access change on 166 Street and Fraser Highway**

Construction of the Surrey Langley SkyTrain Project is underway. Activities in this area include moving existing utilities to allow for construction, installing new utilities to supply power for the future SkyTrain, roadwork, and foundation construction.



To support this work, the following traffic pattern change will take place on 166
Street and Fraser Highway from
September 22, 2025, for up to one month:

- Access to 166 Street is available from Fraser Highway.
- No access to Fraser Highway in both directions from 166 Street.
- Use available detour to exit at one of the following locations:
  - (1) 84 Avenue to 164 Street to access Fraser Highway eastbound
  - (2) Temporary gravel road in place near the Surrey Sport and Leisure Complex available to access Fraser Highway westbound.
- Business access will be maintained.
- Cyclists and pedestrians to follow signage.
- Overnight closure at 166 Street extended until September 26, 2025.
   Use detour route.

#### **Timing**

In effect from 7 a.m. on September 22, 2025, for one month.



#### **Hours of Work**

Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Overnight work from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. ongoing until September 26, 2025. Traffic pattern changes will be in effect 24/7.



#### **Traffic**

No exit to Fraser Highway in both directions from 166 Street.
Alternate routes available.



### Impacts/Interruptions

Temporary access changes at 166 Street and Fraser Highway. The travelling public can expect delays while in the area.
