



## UPDATED: Guideway Construction Underway on Industrial Avenue

This is an update to the [notice](#) distributed on September 10, 2025, to reflect the addition of Saturday work.

Surrey Langley SkyTrain construction is underway, including construction of the elevated guideway on Industrial Avenue (west of the 203 Street intersection).

To support this work, from September 18 until mid-October, large cranes and drill rigs will be in the area completing intermittent piling over six weeks. An increase in noise, vibration, and dust is expected. Construction on this portion of the elevated guideway is anticipated through summer 2026. Access to/from 5735 203 Street is available via 203 Street.

We recognize this work may cause disruption and are committed to reducing impacts on nearby residents and businesses. Our contractor is implementing mitigation measures to significantly reduce disruptions, including the installation of sound barriers and noise monitoring.

#### Timing

September 18, 2025 to mid-October 2025. This timing is subject to change.



#### Hours of Work

**Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.** Crews will make every effort to avoid starting piling work before 7:30 a.m. **No impact piling will occur on the weekends.**
