



Station Construction Underway at Bakerview-166 Street Station

Surrey Langley SkyTrain construction is underway, including construction for the future Bakerview-166 Station at 166 Street and Fraser Highway. Station foundation construction, including pile driving, will begin early December and occur for approximately three months, through mid-February 2026. Driven pile installation involves the use of large mobile cranes and a drill rig. An increase in noise and vibration is expected during this activity.

Existing traffic pattern changes will be maintained, including:

- Single lane traffic in each direction on Fraser Highway.
- Access to businesses and the Surrey Sport and Leisure Centre via 166 Street and 84 Avenue.
- Pedestrians will use the south side of sidewalk on Fraser Highway between 166 Street and 164 Street.

What to Expect



Timing

Pile driving will begin early December 2025 until mid-February 2026. Other construction activities will continue at this location through 2028.



Hours of Work

Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Pile driving activities will occur until 5 p.m.



Traffic

Traffic pattern changes will be in effect 24/7. Signs and traffic control personnel will be on site to direct vehicles and pedestrians as needed during construction.



Impacts/Interruptions

Temporary increases in noise and vibrations are anticipated. Monitoring for noise and vibration will be in place while work is underway.
