




Station Construction Underway at Hillcrest-184 Street Station

Surrey Langley SkyTrain construction is underway, including construction for the future Hillcrest-184 Street Station at Fraser Highway and 184 Street.

Station foundation construction, including pile driving, will begin mid-January 2026 and occur for approximately two months, through mid-March 2026. Driven pile installation involves the use of large mobile cranes and a drill rig. An increase in noise and vibration is expected during this activity.

Existing traffic pattern changes will be maintained, including:

- Single lane traffic in each direction on Fraser Highway.
- Pedestrians to use the existing sidewalk south side of Fraser Highway from Fraser Highway between east of Highway 15 and 184 Street.
- Cyclists share the vehicle lane along 184 Street from 70 Avenue to Fraser Highway.

What to Expect



Timing

Station construction activities: early January 2026
Pile driving: mid-January 2026 until mid-March 2026
Other construction activities: 2028.



Traffic

Traffic pattern changes will be in effect 24/7. Signs and traffic control personnel will be on site to direct vehicles and pedestrians as needed during construction.



Hours of Work

Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Piling activities will occur until 5 p.m.



Impacts/Interruptions

Temporary increases in noise and vibrations are anticipated. Monitoring for noise and vibration will be in place while work is underway.
