



Traffic Update: Fraser Highway and 140 Street



Map: Access change Fraser Highway and 140 Street

Construction of the Surrey Langley SkyTrain is underway, including construction for the future elevated guideway. Foundation work is occurring on Fraser Highway west of 140 Street and requires large, specialized equipment.

To carry out this work, the following traffic pattern changes will be in effect 24/7 beginning February 9, 2026, for up to one month.

- Access to businesses west of 140 Street is available from 140 Street southbound only.
- No left turn from Fraser Highway eastbound onto 140 Street northbound.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Single lane traffic in each direction on Fraser Highway.
- Current left turn restrictions, including westbound Fraser Highway to southbound 140 Street, and southbound 140 Street to eastbound Fraser Highway, are in place.

What to Expect



Timing

In effect February 9, 2026, for up to one month.



No left turn from eastbound Fraser Highway to 140 Street northbound. Access to businesses from 140 Street southbound.



Hours of Work

Monday to Sunday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Traffic pattern changes will be in effect 24/7.



Impacts/Interruptions

The travelling public can expect delays while in the area. Temporary increases in noise are anticipated while work is underway.
