



Traffic Update: Access change on 166 Street north of Fraser Highway

Surrey Langley SkyTrain construction is underway, including utility installations.

To support this work, the following traffic pattern change will be in effect 24/7 starting March 9, 2026, for up to two weeks.

- No access north end of 166 Street.
- Alternate routes to/from Surrey Sport & Leisure Complex (1) westbound Fraser Highway west of 166 Street (2) eastbound Fraser Highway via 164 Street or 168 Street to 84 Avenue.
- Business access will be maintained on 166 Street.
- Single lane traffic in each direction on Fraser Highway.
- Cyclists to follow the same routing as cars for access to businesses.

From March 21-April 18, 2026, work on 166 Street north of Fraser Highway will continue, and single lane traffic will be in effect. Traffic control will be in place to help direct traffic. Access to businesses will be maintained.



Timing

March 9 for up to two weeks. Single lane traffic on 166 Street March 21 to April 18, 2026.



Hours of Work

Monday to Sunday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Traffic pattern changes will be in effect 24/7.

Limited access on 166 Street north of Fraser Highway.



Impacts/Interruptions

The travelling public can expect delays while in the area. Temporary increases in noise are anticipated while work is underway.
