



Weekly Traffic Advisory: August 17 to August 23, 2026

Surrey Langley SkyTrain construction is underway, including relocating existing utilities to allow for construction, installing new utilities to supply power for the future SkyTrain, roadwork, foundation construction, column construction, elevated guideway installation and other activities.

This advisory outlines traffic pattern changes from August 17 to August 23, 2026. Workplans and schedules are subject to change.

Please note that single lane traffic in each direction throughout the project area is expected until project completion. There will be intermittent, short-term lane closures on approaches to intersections, including stoppages of up to two minutes. These may not be reflected in this weekly traffic advisory. Cyclists can expect changes to bike lanes and multi-use paths along Fraser Highway while construction is underway. We have included information for cyclists in this advisory for planned traffic pattern changes.

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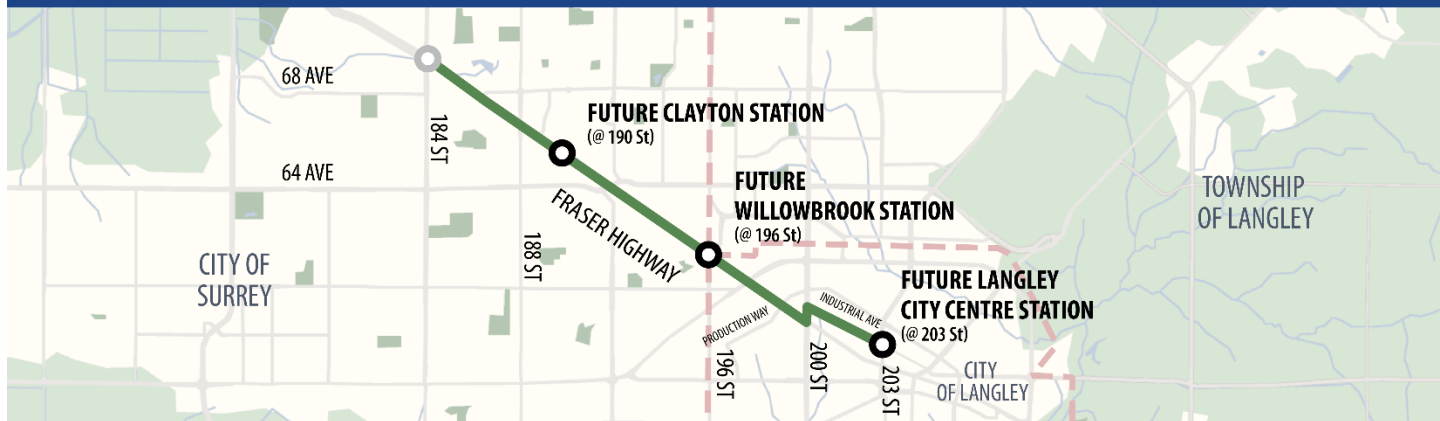
